- 1. There should be a prompt/direction of what is needed for the final presentation. Only a grading rubrics was attached, which is not sufficient. 2. Every professor I had class in Stony Brook gave a chance to read the drafts of essays and encouraged it. But neither professor will do it. How would someone know they are heading in the right direction and not be penalized. Feedback is necessary.
